

I. Leave of Absence System

1 Outline of the leave of absence system

1. Rikkyo divides the school year into two semesters: the spring semester from April 1 to September 19 and the fall semester from September 20 to March 31 of the following year.
2. Academic year for April enrollees begins in the spring semester and continues into the subsequent fall semester. For September enrollees it begins in the fall semester and continues into the subsequent spring semester. However, if students enroll in the NEXUS program (excluding students in the College of Intercultural Communication), the student's first year will begin in the fall semester following their enrollment and include the following spring and fall semesters, and from their second year the academic year will begin with the next spring semester.
3. The periods above are for the 2026 academic year. Please note that the leave of absence schedule changes every academic year. In principle, the deadline for requesting a leave of absence is two months before the last day of the spring semester final examinations for the spring semester, and two months before the last day of the fall semester and final examinations for the fall semester.
4. For September enrollees, regardless of whether students take a leave of absence or not, the academic year will progress on September 20. However, if students enroll in the NEXUS program (excluding students in the College of Intercultural Communication), the academic year will progress on April 1 at the beginning of the spring semester which is the fourth semester of the student, regardless of any leave of absence. In and after the student's second year, regardless of whether students take a leave of absence or not, the academic year will progress on April 1.

II. Handling of Academic Fees

For students taking a leave of absence or withdrawing from school, academic fees are handled as follows:

1. Academic fees for students taking a leave of absence

If students submit a leave of absence request and receives permission to take a leave of absence, they will be exempt from academic fees (tuition, experiment and practical training fees) excluding the semester enrollment fee for the duration of their leave of absence. Semester enrollment fees are normally included in tuition which is a part of the academic fees paid by the student. Semester enrollment fees are collected even when students take a leave of absence.

(1) Semester enrollment fee

All students are charged a semester enrollment fee as the cost of the certification, management and administration of their enrollment in the program they are enrolled in. Semester enrollment fee during leaves of absence are 120,000 yen a year (60,000 yen for each semester), and they are charged per semester during a student's leave of absence. Please note that in addition to the enrollment fee, other fees are required. Please refer to P.5(3) Collection of other payments.

(3) Collection of other payments

Other payments must be paid as follows, regardless of whether or not a leave of absence is approved.

- Research membership fee (excluding first year to third year of undergraduate student and graduate student), Rikkyo Student Mutual-Aid Health Insurance Union fee
These fees will be collected in both the spring semester and the fall semester.
- Lifetime membership fee of the Rikkyo Alumni Association (only undergraduate students)
For April enrollees, this fee will be collected in the spring semester of the student's fourth year of enrollment. For September enrollees, the fee will be collected in the fall semester of their fourth year of enrollment.
However, the fee will be collected from students enrolled in the NEXUS program (excluding students in the College of Intercultural Communication) in the spring semester of their fourth year.

2. Academic fees for students withdrawing from school

If students apply to withdraw from school and receives permission to withdraw, they are required to pay the academic fees necessary for the semester they are withdrawing.

(2) Collection of other payments

Other payments must be paid as follows, regardless of whether or not permission to withdraw from school is approved.

(i) April enrollees

■ Research membership fee (excluding first year to third year of undergraduate student and graduate student)

In case of ① in the above table: Exempt

In case of ② in the above table: The fees will be collected in the spring semester.

In case of ③ in the above table: The fees will be collected in the spring semester and the fall semester.

■ Rikkyo Student Mutual-Aid Health Insurance Union fee

In case of ① and ② in the above table: The fees will be collected in the spring semester.

In case of ③ in the above table: The fees will be collected in the spring semester and the fall semester.

(ii) September enrollees (excluding students enrolled in the NEXUS program (excluding students in the College of Intercultural Communication))

■ Research membership fee (excluding first year to third year of undergraduate student and graduate student)

In case of ④ in the above table: Exempt

In case of ⑤ in the above table: The fees will be collected in the fall semester.

In case of ⑥ in the above table: The fees will be collected in the fall semester and the spring semester.

■ Rikkyo Student Mutual-Aid Health Insurance Union fee

In case of ④ and ⑤ in the above table: The fees will be collected in the fall semester.

In case of ⑥ in the above table: The fees will be collected in the fall semester and the spring semester.

(iii) Students in the first year of the NEXUS program (excluding students in the College of Intercultural Communication)

■ Rikkyo Student Mutual-Aid Health Insurance Union fee

In case of ⑦ in the above table: The fees for the fall semester that is the first semester of the student's first year will be collected.

In case of ⑧ in the above table: The fees will be collected in the fall semester and the spring semester that are the first and second semesters of the student's first year, respectively.

In case of ⑨ in the above table: The fees will be collected in the fall semester that is the first semester, the spring semester that is the second semester, and the fall semester that is the third semester of the student's first year.
